RECAP

[Amplify Natural Resources Dividend Income ETF \(NDIV\)](#) seeks investment results that generally correspond to the price and yield of the EQM Natural Resources Dividend Income Index. The Index is comprised of dividend-paying U.S. exchange-listed equities operating primarily in the natural resource and commodity-related industries such as: energy, chemicals, agriculture, metals & mining, paper products, and timber. NDIV returned -4.15% on a net asset value (NAV) compared to its benchmark, the EQM Natural Resources Dividend Income Index at -4.12% for the month as of December 31, 2022. The top contributing industry to the portfolio was energy equipment & services (1.27%). All the remaining industries within the portfolio detracted to NDIV's return. Oil, gas & consumable fuels (53.70%), detracted the most, followed by chemicals (12.42%) and metals & mining (32.59%), respectively. Positions that contributed most significantly included Ecopetrol (4.43%) and Rio Tinto PLC (3.41%). Positions that detracted most significantly included ICL Group LTD (3.02%) and Gerdau (3.37%), respectively.
